- Total number of schools (PS + UPS) 70,958 (BEPC AWP)
- Children **enrolled** 20,900,000 (BEPC AWP)
- OoSC (2019-20) 1,44,380 (PAB)
- Operationalized **quarantine** center 15,036 (Till 23.05.2020 as per disaster management department)
- **Number** of people in quarantine center-1,56,852 (Till 23.05.2020 as per disaster management department)
- Number of Shramik trains **sanctioned** for Bihar 752
- Number of Migrant worker **registered** to use Shramik train 1,007,668
- Number of migrant worked arrived in Bihar from 368 Shramik special train 4,70,365 (till 20.05.2020)
- Number of notification released by GoB in context of Education 3 (School closure/ online teaching learning process/ class promotion)
